Dear friends and families,

We continue to monitor and follow the latest <u>Centers for Disease Control (CDC)</u> COVID-19 infection control guidance with relation to its impact on our residents and visitors. Residents who are on transmission-based precautions for COVID-19 should only receive visits that are virtual, through windows, or in-person for compassionate care situations, with adherence to transmission-based precautions and core infection control principles.

Here are the latest care guidelines for retirement community and independent living residents from the CDC.

Residents of Country Springs are permitted to have in-room visitation and outings. The following are required:

- Screening
- Masking is required
- Social distancing
- Visits are limited in the designated areas if in a semi-private room.

We encourage all residents, staff, family members and volunteers to become vaccinated. For information about vaccination information, please check the <u>CDC's fact sheet</u>.
